The Modern Languages Teaching Centre (MLTC), currently a section of the School of Languages and Cultures within the Faculty of Arts and Humanities, delivers non-specialist language training from absolute beginner to near-native levels in French, German, Italian and Spanish, and at beginner and post-beginner levels in Arabic, Latin, and Portuguese, to all students of the University, undergraduates and postgraduates students alike, as well as staff and members of the local community. Subject to approval by the University's Council, the MLTC is due to transfer to Student Services on 1st August 2016 and seeks to appoint a Teaching Associate in Italian to join its team. The successful applicant will be responsible for assisting the Italian Co-ordinator in supervising some of the Italian modules and for delivering teaching courses from beginners' to advanced levels, developing and updating materials as appropriate. You will co-ordinate and support the work of colleagues on team-taught modules and contribute to administrative duties in relation to these courses and to the Italian provision as a whole.

You will have native or near-native proficiency in Italian with knowledge of current affairs and cultural life in Italian-speaking countries and regions, a good track record in teaching Italian in higher education for general and possibly specific purposes, and experience of acting as module leader or leading a small team. You will have a degree involving Italian (or equivalent experience), a teaching qualification,

and a strong commitment to professional development and the delivery of a high-quality, innovative language-learning experience to students.

This open-ended post has a start date of 1 September 2016 or as soon as possible thereafter. The post is part-time (0.5 FTE) over 10 months per annum (1 September - 30 June), but additional hours up to 1.0 FTE may be available over that period next academic year depending on student recruitment. We anticipate that interviews will be held on 29 June 2016.
